Garage Door Opener



1 While the car is ON, hold the handheld garage door transmitter 1-3 inches from the HomeLink® button you want to program in the vehicle.

2 Push and hold both the HomeLink® button being programmed and the button on the garage door transmitter.

TO ERASE ALL SET CHANNELS:

Push and hold the two outside HomeLink® buttons for 20 seconds until the orange indicator flashes. An individual channel cannot be erased.



ROLLING OR NON-ROLLING?

Check your garage door opener motor in your garage for a “LEARN” or “TRAIN” button by the hanging antenna. If you have one of these, you have a Rolling Code garage door opener.

For Non-Rolling Code garage door openers, watch for the indicator light to go constant.

For Rolling Code garage door openers, watch for the indicator light to go from a slow blink to blinking rapidly.

For Rolling Code garage door openers only, firmly push and release the “LEARN” or “TRAIN” button on your garage door opener motor in your garage, then push the HomeLink® button in your vehicle for two long presses.

If the programming was successful, your garage door should open and close with your chosen HomeLink® button.

Pair a Phone



1 Make sure Bluetooth® is enabled on your mobile device.

2 With the vehicle in the ACC or ON/RUN position, press the Phone button on the vehicle's touchscreen menu bar.

3 Press "Pairing".

4 Press "Paired Phones and Audio Devices".

5 Select "Add Device" then follow the prompts on your phone and on the touchscreen.

CONNECT YOUR APPS

Connect your smartphone to the media USB port.

The Android Auto™ or Apple CarPlay® icon will replace the phone icon on the touchscreen.

KEEP IN MIND:



For Android™ Users, if the Android Auto™ app was not previously downloaded, it will download the first time you plug in your device.



For Apple® Users, Apple CarPlay® is only compatible with iPhone® 5 or later and requires Siri being enabled in Settings.

Ready to remove a phone or audio device?

1 Press the Pairing button on the touchscreen.

2 Press "Paired Phones and Audio Devices".

3 Press "Settings" next to the phone or device you want to remove.

4 Press "Delete Device".

5 Press "X" to exit the settings screen. The device should be removed.

KEEP IN MIND:

Vehicles sold in Canada are equipped with a headlight switch with an AUTO and ON detent but without an OFF detent. Headlights will be deactivated when the headlight switch is placed in the parking lights position. However, the Daytime Running Lights will be activated along with the front and rear marker lights.

Climate Controls

Rotating the **Blower Control Knob** regulates the amount of air forced through the system in any mode.

TIP:

Push the **red arrow** button to increase the temperature or push the **blue arrow** button to decrease the temperature for the driver and/or the passenger.

Deluxe Vehicle Security System

The Deluxe Vehicle Security system monitors your doors, hood latch, trunk, and ignition switch for unauthorized entry and operation. It also monitors your vehicle with dual function intrusion sensors and vehicle tilt sensors.

To Arm The System

- 1 Make sure the ignition is OFF.
Push the interior power lock switch, push the lock button on a Passive Entry door handle, or push the lock button on the key fob.
- 2 Ensure the doors, windows, and sunroof are closed.
- 3

To Disarm The System

- 1 Push the unlock button on the key fob or grab the Passive Entry door handle to unlock the door.
- 2 Cycle the vehicle ignition system out of the OFF position.

TIP:

The intrusion sensor can be disabled by pressing the lock button on the key fob three times within 15 seconds of arming the system while the Vehicle Security Light is flashing rapidly.

KEEP IN MIND:

The Deluxe Vehicle Security system will not arm if you lock the doors using the manual door lock.



Advanced Driver Assistance Systems



Use these buttons to activate your **Cruise Control system** and set your speed.



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ACC Video



Use these buttons to activate your **Adaptive Cruise Control (ACC) system** and set your following distance.



Scan For
FCW Video



Turn the **Forward Collision Warning (FCW) system** on or off, and adjust the sensitivity through your radio.



TIP:

Through the Uconnect touchscreen, you can access **Performance Pages** or **SRT Drive Modes (if equipped)**. You can access Launch Mode or adjust vehicle performance settings with Sport Mode or Track Mode. Refer to the Performance Features Guide for further information.



Turn your **ParkSense system** on or off by using the ParkSense switch. The chime volume settings can be programmed through your radio.

Use your radio to choose between three **Blind Spot Monitoring system** modes:

- Blind Spot Alert Lights Only
- Blind Spot Alert Lights/Chime
- Blind Spot Alert Off
